In pursuance to University of Kashmir Notification No. 2019 No. F(Admn NT BG 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester's)Reg/KU/19 dated: 17-01-2019, it is notified for the information of all those candidates who are desirous of seeking admission to undergraduate programme in BA/B.Sc./B.Com/BCA/BBA/BMMMC 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester 2019 (Regular) to follow the guidelines as given below:

### Eligibility

1. The applicant candidate/s must have passed their 10+2 exam for the Jammu & Kashmir State Board of School Education or any other recognized Board whose examinations have been considered as equivalent to the corresponding examination.
2. The candidate/s whose result is awaited or are appearing in the 10+2 exam of CBSE or any other recognized Board or have applied for re-evaluation shall be eligible to apply for provisional admission on their own risk and responsibility. However, such candidates shall be required to pay a non-refundable fee of Rs.500/- in lieu of admission fee in the College concerned and their admission shall be subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions as laid down in the statutes. They shall be required to submit the required documents along with the admission and examination fee within 10 days after attaining eligibility.
3. The candidates seeking admission to B.Sc programme shall have passed the qualifying exam with not less than 45% marks in case of Open / General Category and 40% marks in case of Reserved Categories.
4. Candidate/s having passed the 12th class examination with Science/Home Science/Commerce subject may be allowed to opt for Arts subjects. However, candidates with non-commerce background seeking admission in commerce stream may have passed the qualifying examination with at least 45% marks in case of Open Category/General Category and 40% in case of Reserved Categories.

### Admission Procedure for Fixed Intake Courses:

Courses/subjects that are listed below have fixed intake capacity as mentioned against each and as such admission to these Courses/subjects will be determined on the basis of merit in qualifying examination (10+2) except in case of Bachelors in Mass Communication and Multimedia Production (BMMMC) where in an entrance examination is to be held as per the scheduled given below:
